From June 18-20, 2025, Hangzhou Grand Convention and Exhibition Center became the focus of global gas industry. IG CHINA 2025 International Gas Exhibition was grandly held and successfully concluded here. This exhibition, with its grand scale, rich activities and profound industry discussions, has broken the records of previous sessions and built a high-standard and high-efficiency communication platform for global gas industry cooperation.

500 guests from home an aboard gathered together, and the exhibition scale of 30,000 square meters set a new record:

At opening ceremony, 500 domestic and foreign guests gathered together and witnessed the grand event in this industry. Among them, the presence of leaders from 10 overseas gas industry associations and 300 entrepreneurs added strong international atmosphere to the exhibition. In Exhibition Hall No.2, a variety of equipment for entire gas production process are on display. Gas production auxiliary equipment and materials, gas products, gas analyzers and gas detection equipment are all on display. Hall 3 focuses on gas storage and transport, automatic filling, pressure vessels and related supporting equipment. This includes storage devices like cryogenic tanks for industrial gases, LNG storage tanks, gas cylinders, and Dewar flasks. It also covers auxiliary equipment such as cryogenic pumps, vacuum pumps, and vaporizers. Furthermore, it showcases gas information management technology, such as cylinder safety management software, electronic tags (RFID), and the Internet of Things (IoT). It reflects the development trend of the gas industry in terms of intelligentize and informatization.

During the grand opening ceremony, the highly anticipated "Map of China's Gas Industry Chain Agglomeration Zones" was officially released.

This meticulously crafted industry map serves as a navigational platform for the first batch of 100 carefully selected target enterprises and their innovative products, facilitating precise matchmaking with the international market. It provides overseas guests and professional buyers with comprehensive and intuitive information on the layout of China's gas industry chain, thus becoming a vital bridge for promoting international cooperation.
